



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AND

Whereas Centre for Innovations in Public Systems (CIPS) is established in May 2010, as an autonomous body within the campus of the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI), Hyderabad. This centre is set up in pursuance to the recommendations of the XIII Finance commission.

In line with its mandate and objectives, CIPS is working with State Governments, Union Territories and Govt. of India Organizations for promoting an innovative culture for transforming creative ideas into sustainable practices. - v. To act as a platform for process engineering in public systems through use of technology and best practices.
